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Dredging For Sediment

Dredging can occur to remove unwanted material, but it is also performed to generate a supply of sediment.

California beachers are moving at record rates. For both natural, man-made and artificial dunes, regular maintenance with beachers is critical for dune stability. This process used beach nourishment occurs every few months, often after large storms or events that erode the beach. Beach nourishment is small-scale.

Large-scale beaching, large projects aimed at beach restoration or dune stabilization, often occur in coastal neighborhoods that were built from material dredged from the bottom of the sea.
